

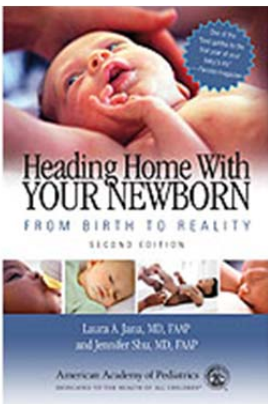
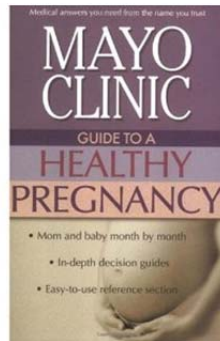

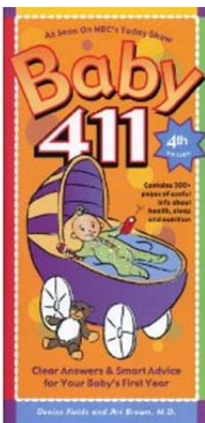


Newborn Care:

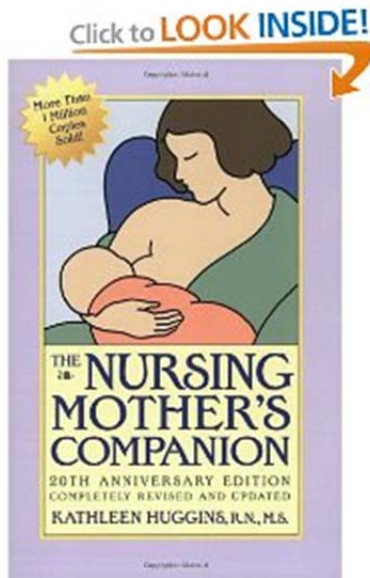

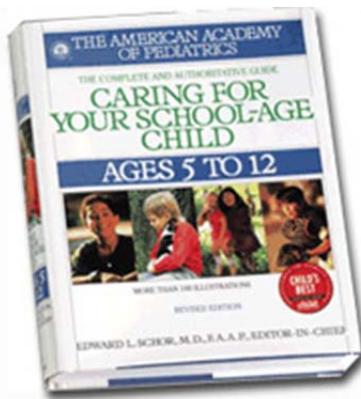
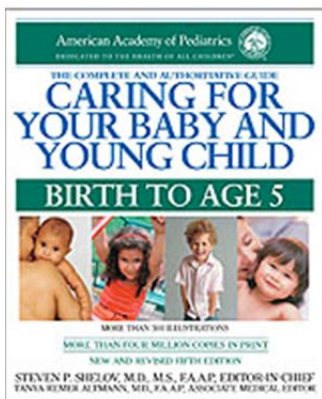
